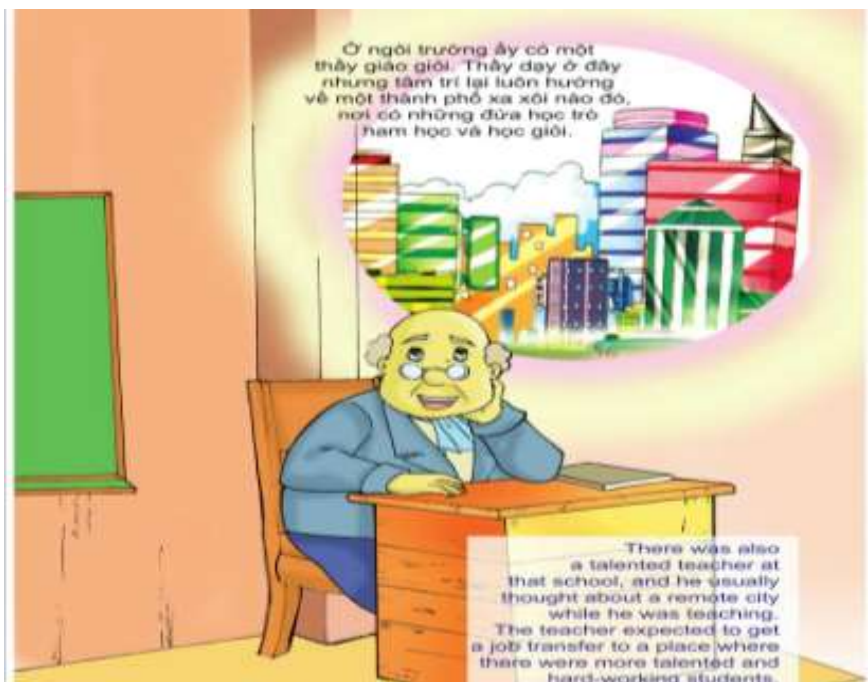
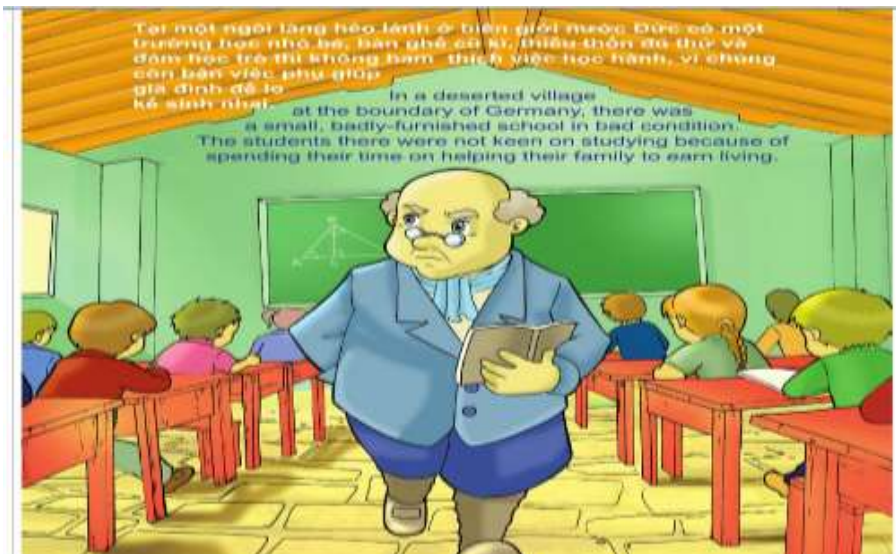

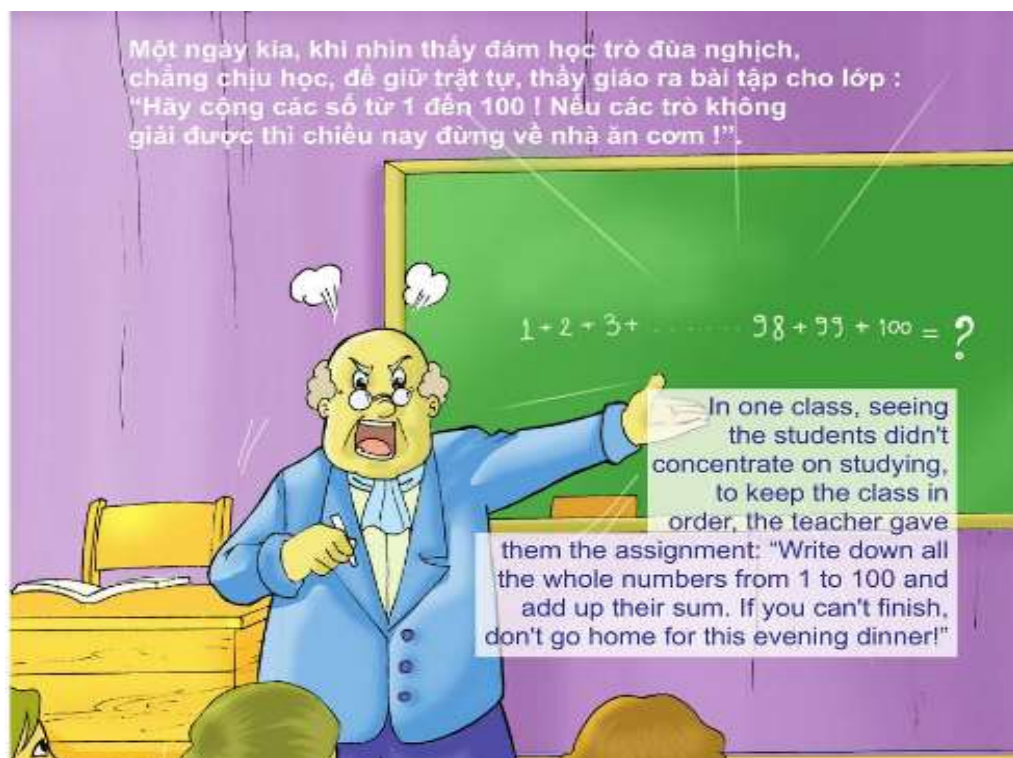

# READING: SIR, I KNOW IT! THƯA THẦY EM BIẾT Ạ!





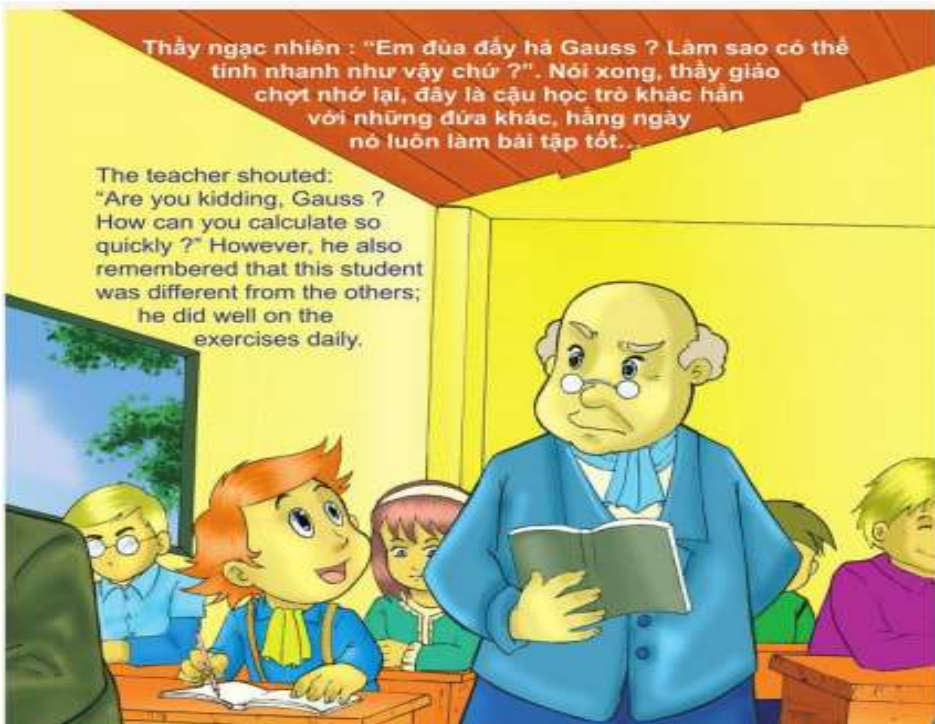
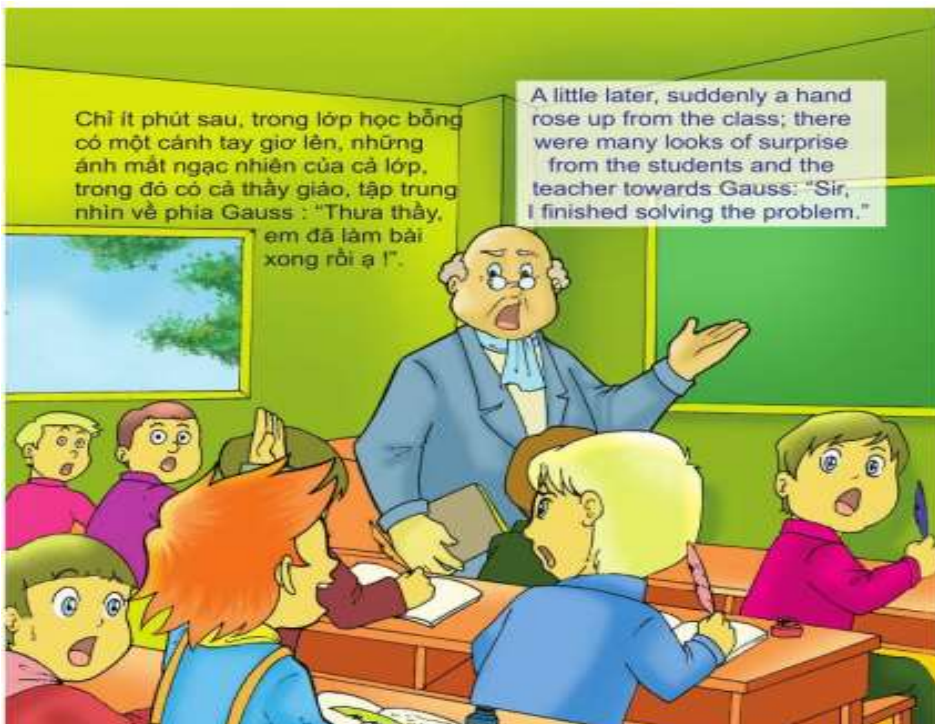

Gauss hummed and hawed: "Got it!"

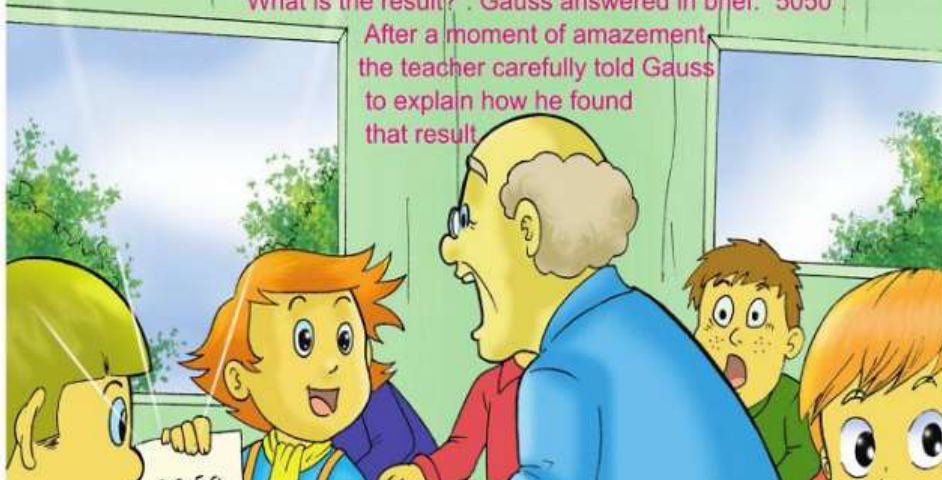




Thầy bèn nghiêm nét mặt hỏi trò : "Kết quả là bao nhiêu ?".

The teacher happily said loudly:

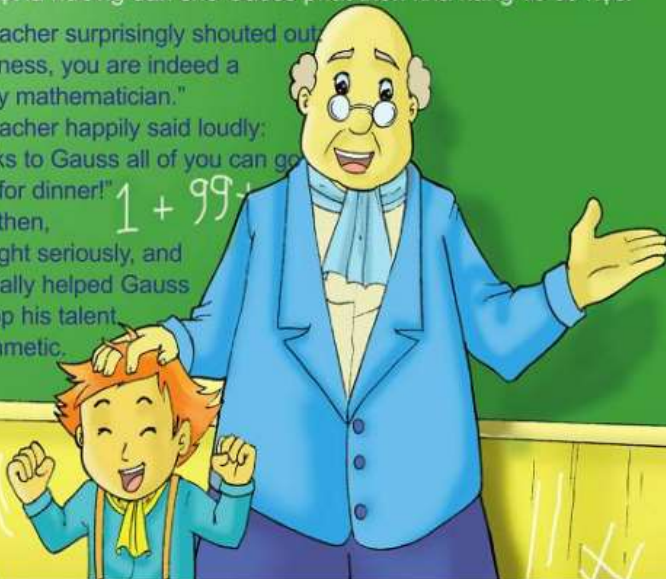
"Thanks to Gauss all of you can go

“Không, thưa cô, nhưng em không thích thấy cô đứng đó một mình.”

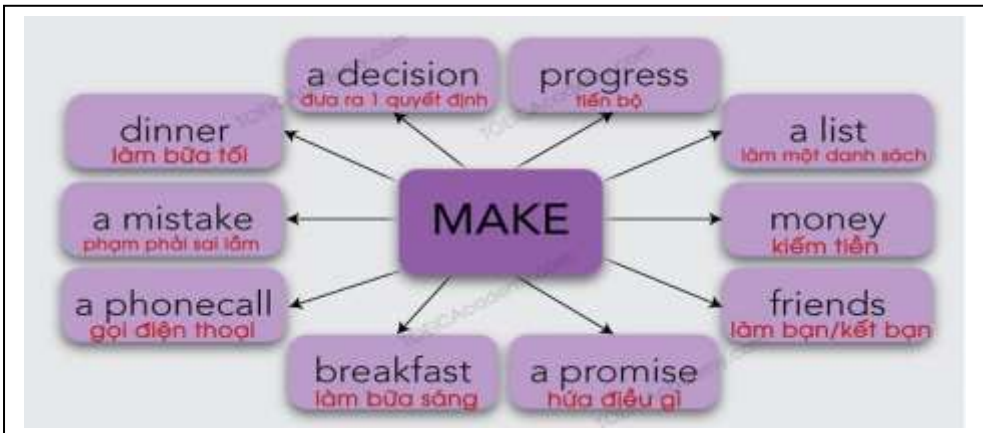


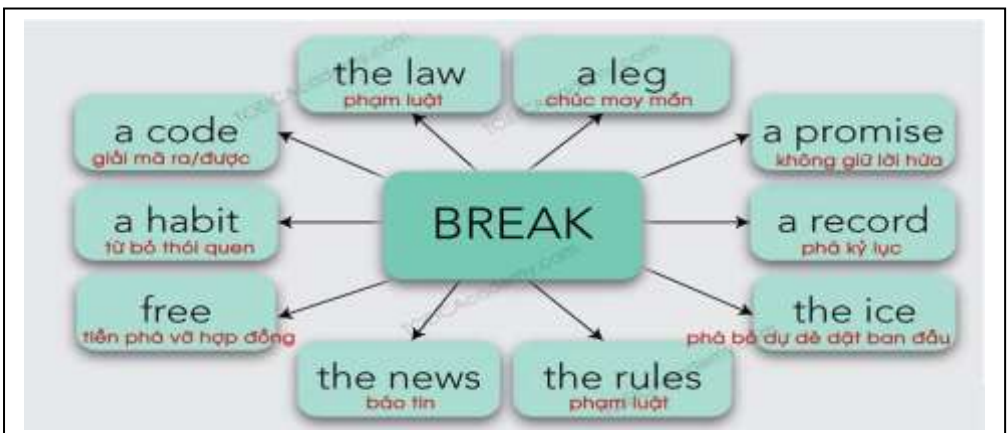
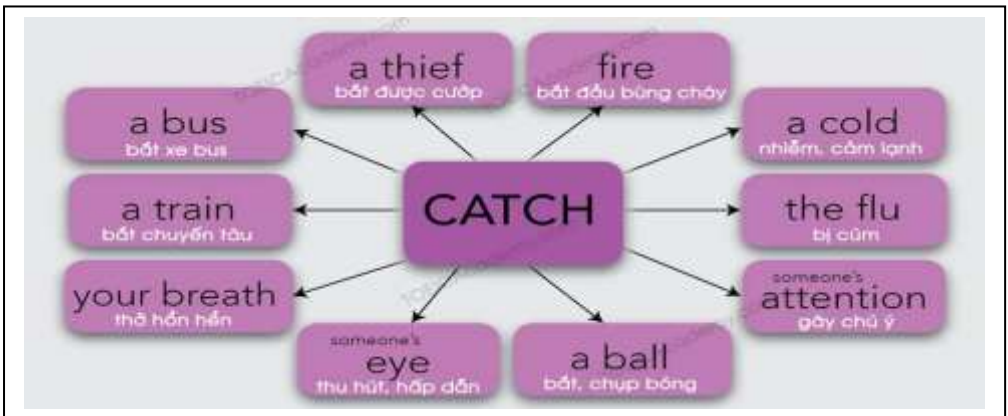
